Community Wednesday Weekly Update

This week we provided grocery parcels to 54 households, of which 18 were also Foodbank. We delivered to 30 households.

And, of course, why we are so grateful for the volunteers (both church and Brent Foodbank) sorting and packing produce from Wednesday morning, in addition to the Foodbank volunteers who work in the church temporary warehouse.

Church Re-Opening - Official Advice so far:

Quite a few folks have been asking us- '*When can the LPBC building be opened again for worship?*' We hope this will update everyone on the current position of the church:

1) Worship Services:

The Government have said that their aim is for places of worship to be able to open for worship services, subject to the 2 metres social distancing measures, after 4th July.

As you may realize from the difficulty that primary schools have had - if this plan is put in place it will restrict how many people can gather.

A task force are working with Government representatives to discuss 'when and how' and we are waiting for the London Baptist Association to give us these details in the coming weeks.

2) Prayer Space

From Monday 15th June, the Government are allowing churches to open for individual prayer. However, we are not yet able to offer that because the building is at socially distanced capacity with Foodbank volunteers.

LPBC Deacons Discussion on Worship Services

Don't forget: Roger & the Deacons are ringing folk up to stay in contact and are trying to make sure we coordinate it to prevent you receiving either too many calls / texts, or none at all. As humans we are prone to mistakes so please do let us know if we have not quite got the balance right yet.

Church Greetings - To help keep us connected and to see each other, please can you record a short greeting on your smart phone saying hello and how you are doing? It only needs to be 30 seconds or so. We will share one or two in the Sunday service each week.

If you do not have a smart phone one of the team may be able to come to you and record you on your doorstep using theirs - just ask!
